The business meeting is open to anyone who is interested in the operation of the division. Members at the meeting: Bob Chin, Lulu Sun, Jennifer McInnis, Mary, Pat, Sheryl, Jeremy, Dan, Aaron, Holly, Norm, Jorge

I. Call to Order

Bob as the division chair called the meeting to order at 12:08 PM. Bob showed the slides proposal completed by Dennis who is the site chair of 73<sup>rd</sup> midyear conference at UC Berkeley in Jan 2019. Dennis noted that if anybody wants to run the program and help him out, please do so.

- II. Review agenda
  - A. Minutes are not available at this moment. Heidi will send out last meeting minutes to everyone for review and approval. Bob briefed the executive meeting last night.
- III. Treasurer's report

Aaron motioned and Bob seconded to open the discussion. Mary questioned how to spend the money in the bass account. Bob mentioned that it will be used to pay the student assistant for website maintenance and travel grants. Sheryl mentioned the indexing of EDGJ. Bob believes it should go through the journal financial account. Aaron pointed out the low submission rate. Sheryl said the situation should get better if we have the impact factor. It could be ~0.13. Sheryl mentioned the large balance of the bass account comparing to the expenditure. Dan wondered if the website cost should be charged to the bass account. Check 1007 should be corrected and the charge should be from the bass account. Sheryl mentioned that we have to be careful with the money we want to put in the bass account. Make sure that Heidi is aware of it. Do not put it in the bass account unless we have to. Bob motioned to accept the treasurer's report as the amendment. Treasurer's report was approved as the amendment by general consent.

Sheryl and Norm are conference chairs. Both are from University of Cincinnati. Sheryl Sorby, Mary Sadowski, and Marva Blankson are co program chairs.
  - 3. Call for 73<sup>rd</sup> midyear conference program chair.
  - 4. Sheryl mentioned that Patty promoted to use ASEE service to manage the midyear conference. Sheryl sensed if ASEE will manage the registration, corporate sponsorship, hotel etc, all incomes will go to the bass account. Patty cannot come to the midyear conference this time because she is in the hospital. Ted needs to be informed the potential issues if Patty pushes to use ASEE service. Dan suggested to use paypal for

future midyear registration collection, which may only charge 2%-3% service fee and is acceptable. Heidi can look into it.

- 5. 74<sup>th</sup> midyear conference will be at Virginia Beach. Petros is the site chair. The proposal needs to be submitted by the annual conference.
- 6. Call for the program chair. The proposal is not submitted yet.
- C. Publication report: AJ' term will be ended by 2018. Election needs to be held in January. Mary suggested to publish the digest in EDGJ. AJ needs to look into it.
  - 1. Financial report: Jeremy should follow up with Nancy to see uncashed check.
- D. Communication report: Jennifer will email everyone in the committee to see if the new website is approved to be published.

- VI. Bylaw committee reports
  - A. Nominating committee

# **Director of Publications Report**

## EDGJ Report

The recipient of the 2017 Editor's Award is Diana Bairaktarova for her paper, "Coordinating Mind and Hand: The Importance of Manual Drawing and Descriptive Geometry Instruction in a CAD-Oriented Engineering Design Graphics Class."

Since the 72<sup>nd</sup> Midyear Conference in Jan. 2018:

- Three issues have been published the Winter, Spring, and Fall 2017 editions
- Six new manuscripts have been submitted
- Five manuscript have been accepted
- One manuscript has been returned to the authors for minor revisions
- No manuscripts have been declined
- Four manuscripts are in review

In May, the Journal received a second flag from Scopus due to its underperformance in 2016. The Journal failed to meet the benchmark on all six metrics. In comparison to other journals in the same subject field (Engineering and Social Sciences) the self-citation rate is too high, the total citation rate is too low, the CiteScore is too low, the number of articles published per year is too low, the number of full-text clicks on Scopus.com is too low, and the abstract usage on Scopus.com is too low. Since it has been flagged as underperforming for two consecutive years (2015 and 2016), the Journal will be re-evaluated by the Content Selection and Advisory Board (CSAB). The CSAB will use criteria similar to the Scopus content selection criteria for new journals: journal policy, quality of content, journal standing, publishing regularity, and online availability.
